

**EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH ALPHANET INFORMATION SYSTEMS LLC
AND INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR:**

Contract made April 21, 2007, between AlphaNet Information Systems LLC, of 9550 East Baileys Trail, Hereford, Cochise County, Arizona, here referred to as owner, and

RECITALS

A. Owner owns and operates an Audio Text Messaging business at the address set forth above, and owner desires to have the following services performed at contractor's place of business, Audio Text Messaging with optional web cam.

B. Contractor agrees to perform these services for owner under the terms and conditions set forth in this contract. Contractor is over the age of 18.

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this contract, it is agreed by and between owner and contractor:

SECTION ONE.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The work to be performed by contractor includes all services generally performed by contractor in contractor's usual line of business, including, but not limited to, the following: Audio Text Messaging and/or web cam during the hours of _____ to _____. Additional hours or time off can be coordinated with the owner.

SECTION TWO.

PAYMENT

Owner will pay contractor the total sum of 1.25 Dollars (\$ 1.25) per authorized and charged minute. Payments will be cut on company check and mailed to the contractor on Monday. There will be a seven (7) day hold to allow the processing of funds.

SECTION THREE.

RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES

The parties intend that an independent contractor-employer relationship will be created by this contract. Owner is interested only in the results to be achieved and the conduct and control of the work will lie solely with contractor. Contractor is not to be considered an agent or employee of owner for any purpose, and the employees of contractor are not entitled to any of the benefits that owner provides for owner's employees. It is understood that owner does not agree to use contractor exclusively. It is further understood that contractor is free to contract for similar services to be performed for other owners while under contract with owner. Contractor agrees to maintain a separate phone line solely for the purposes of contracting with the owner. That phone line will not be used for any other purpose. Contractor agrees to forward all owners phone lines when contractor is not available to work to a toll free numbers designated by the owner.

SECTION FOUR.

OWNERSHIP OF COPYRIGHT

The owner holds and maintains all copyright ownership of all content, web sites and URL's paid for by the owner and anything not belonging to the contractor.

Contractors using their own image hold copyright to those images. On termination of contract, the contractor agrees to allow the owner to use all images used by owner for a period of 90 day after termination of contract.

SECTION FIVE.

LIABILITY

The work to be performed under this contract will be performed entirely at contractor's risk, and contractor assumes all responsibility for the accuracy of charges and client information. Contractor agrees to pay for all charge back fees associated with their charges. Upon termination of contract, the remaining funds to contractor will be held for 90 days pending any charge backs.

Owner will pay for the first thirty (30) days all costs of the contractors toll free costs associated with the owners business. Owner will pay for all service fees associated with any charge back not including the portion paid to the contractor. Owner agrees to set on a solo site and place the contractor on one multi-girl site. Any further additions can be made during the term of the contract.

SECTION FIVE.

DURATION

Either party may cancel this contract on Seven (7) days' written notice; otherwise, the contract shall remain in force for a term of the mutual agreement between the parties..

The owner reserves the right to terminate contract with out notice if contractor violates USC 18 title 2257, or any other law or regulation regarding adult material. Owner will send all material regarding any violation of 2257 to the FBI.

Owner can also terminate contract if contractor is found to be defrauding the owner.
